Re: Relocation of No. 11 Fire Station from 7109 Westminster Drive to 3970 Savoy Street

The City of London is relocating the staff and vehicles from the current Fire Station No. 11 at 7109 Westminster Drive to a new fire station at 3970 Savoy Street. You are invited to attend a Community Meeting where we will provide information regarding this project. Child minding is available for the duration of the meeting.

WHAT: *Relocation of No. 11 Fire Station*

WHERE: *Lambeth Community Centre, 7112 Beattie Street, London, ON*

WHEN: *Wednesday, March 2, 2016 beginning at 7:00 pm*

The Fire Master Plan presented to Council in 2009 recommended that Fire Station No. 11 be relocated to improve service levels to the existing Lambeth Community. This move will help address increased service demand as a result of growth in the area identified within the South West Area Plan. In addition, moving the station significantly improves secondary response to White Oaks, the commercial and retail occupancies along Exeter Rd., as well as Byron and Westmount. Relocating the current staff and vehicles is a cost effective method of addressing current and future service demands. The reverse side of this letter shows the location of the new fire station.

The construction is scheduled to begin in the late summer of 2016 with completion anticipated in late spring of 2017.
